New Patrol Vehicles Prowling County

(Woodbine, GA, February 24, 2014) - Last week several new Camden County Sheriff's Office (CCSO) vehicles set out to patrol the county. A total of six new Chevrolet Tahoe's will be hard at work serving the community as part of a cooperative effort between the Camden Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) and the CCSO. On Friday, February 21, 2014, Sheriff Proctor met with BOCC Chairman Jimmy Starline to thank him and all the other Commissioners, as well as County Administrator Steve Howard, for their hard work and willingness to work together for the common goal of providing the citizens of Camden County the best possible law enforcement service.

After much research and deliberation the Tahoe's were chosen to replace the venerable and ubiquitous but no longer available Ford Crown Victoria. County taxpayers are getting the most for their money because the Tahoe is the most reliable, cost effective and practical vehicle for patrolling all of Camden County. The new patrol vehicles will provide deputies the performance, speed and safety they need and add additional space needed for K-9 units. The first three vehicles were delivered on Valentine's Day.
