A life-long resident of Camden County, Heidi became involved with the election process in 2008 when she began working in the Waverly polling place during the March Presidential Preference Primary Election.

As a poll-officer for the next 2 years, Heidi worked every Election Day in different voting precincts, before being hired by the Board of Registrars in 2011.

Heidi's current duties include registering new voters, updating voter information and purging the voter list of those no longer eligible to vote in Camden County. She is also responsible for the 3 weeks of Early Voting prior to every election, and all absentee voting.

Heidi attends yearly training provided by the Secretary of State's office in order to remain a Certified Elections Official for Camden County.

Prior to working in Elections for Judge Gillette and being hired by the Board of Registrars, Heidi was an Avon Representative locally for 6 years. She has also been employed with United 1st Federal Credit Union as a teller, and for Historic America as the administrative secretary.
