- Providing verification of voter's and voter information;
- Assigning voter's to appropriate Districts and Precincts;
- Assisting with the training of Poll Officers; and
- Expediting all Absentee Voting.

Robin has also been employed with the Southeast Georgia Health System (SGHS) Admissions Department for the last 8 years. Prior to working with SGHS, Robin worked with Dr. Mary Lee Carter and the Camden County Board of Education.

Robin currently serves as a Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) for the Camden County area and is a voice for children in the system. By being their voice, she helps to prevent them from feeling lost and abandoned. Robin is trained to speak for the best interests of our abused and neglected children involved in the juvenile court system.
