Public Notice Old Still Yard Waste Site Open Saturday

WOODBINE, Ga. – September 6, 2019 – The Camden County Solid Waste Authority will open the Old Still Yard Waste Site on Saturday, September 7, 2019, from 7:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. The site, located at 4884 Old Still Road in Kingsland, will be open for Camden County households to bring their Hurricane Dorian-related yard debris at no charge.

Additionally the Construction and Demolition (C & D) Industrial Waste Landfill, located at 1600 Georgia Highway 110 in Woodbine, will accept yard debris at no charge from Camden County households. The C & D Landfill is open Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. and Saturday, 7:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.

Please note this is only for vegetative debris and solid waste will not be accepted. Commercial entities will be charged for debris.
