The meeting schedule is as follows:

- Wednesday, August 30, 2023 – Browntown Wilderness Park, 146 Temple Landing Road, Kingsland (District 5);
- Thursday, August 31, 2023 – Harriett’s Bluff Community Park, 7331 Harrietts Bluff Road, Woodbine (District 2);
- Wednesday, September 6, 2023 – Maple Ford Park, 2059 Spring Bluff Road, Waverly (District 1); and
- Thursday, September 7, 2023 – Cornelia Jackson Memorial Park, 201 15th Street, Woodbine (District 1).

Each meeting will take place from 6:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. at the park’s pavilion. Representatives from the Camden County Board of Commissioners and staff will attend along with representatives from the Camden County Public Service Authority (PSA).
